## The First Health Network

Health Net has an arrangement with First Health, a national network of doctors and hospitals throughout the U.S. This arrangement allows you as a Health Net PPO member to receive health care services at a contracted rate whether you reside or travel out of Oregon and Washington.

## Choose a First Health provider

To ensure you get in-network benefits when visiting a provider for regular services<sup>1</sup> **outside** of Oregon and Washington, ask the provider if he or she participates in the First Health Network.

If you receive care from a provider not contracted with First Health, you may have to pay higher out-of-pocket costs at the time of service and will then need to submit a claim to receive your reimbursement.

# Find a national provider online

Health Net is here to make finding a provider easy for you. With our ProviderSearch tool, you can find a doctor, hospital, urgent care center, or any provider in our national PPO network quickly.
